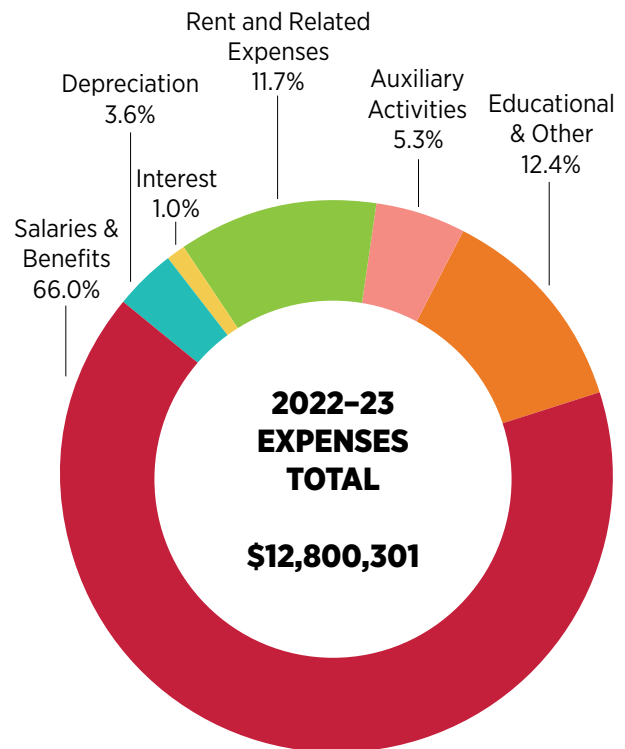
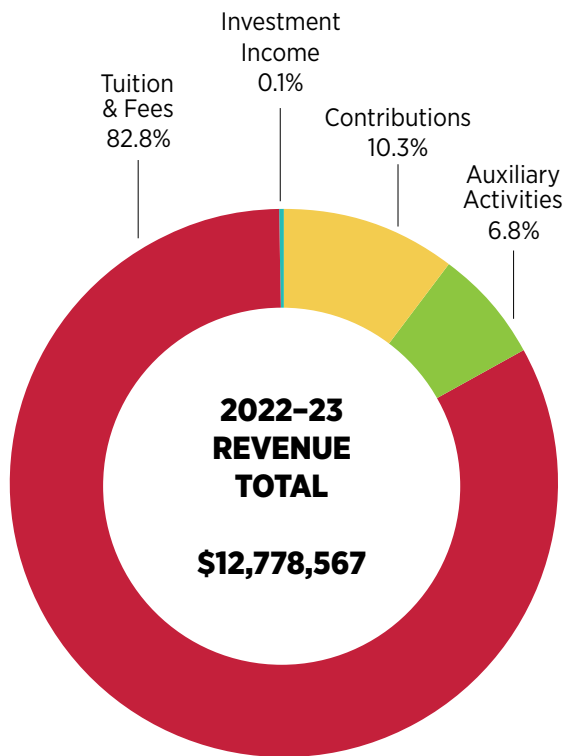




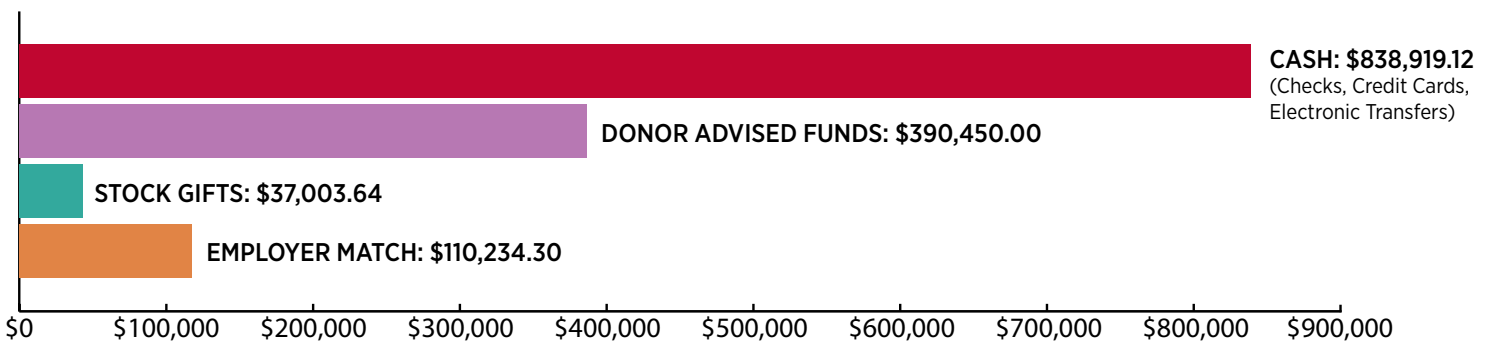

Philanthropy Fuels Elementary Mathematics Partnership

Thanks to ongoing philanthropic support, Kingsley’s four-year partnership with Lesley University’s Center for Mathematics Achievement had a highly productive launch in 2022–2023, with equally promising aspirations for 2023–2024.

Year One: Setting the Stage

Year One saw our Lesley University partners on campus, observing classes, interviewing teachers, and working with our faculty to articulate our priorities and identify a new mathematics curriculum. We developed the mathematics scope and sequence for Grades 3-5 and produced Kingsley’s first school wide Math Charter.

Year Two: New Methods and Practices

2023–2024 is the Grades 3–6 rollout year for [Illustrative Mathematics \(IM\)](#), a rigorous and robust curriculum that will support our students in developing a deep conceptual understanding of math. For First and Second Grades, our faculty and coaches are developing Kingsley Math Albums, merging Montessori math with Illustrative Mathematics to create a uniquely impactful Kingsley Math Program.

Melding IM and Montessori Math

Shelby Strong, Elementary and Secondary Math Consultant at the Center for Mathematics Achievement shared historical perspective: “In Maria Montessori’s day, math was taught in algorithms. There was no emphasis on deep conceptual understanding—the focus was

on memorization. Dr. Montessori found ways to make algorithms tangible through physical materials. Today, math educators have a better understanding of how people learn math. We appreciate the enduring value of Dr. Montessori’s approach, while recognizing that

some elements of a comprehensive mathematics education fall outside of traditional Montessori math. Illustrative Mathematics is an ideal bridge between our foundational Montessori approach and the robust

benchmarks we have affirmed for Kingsley students.”

Looking Ahead

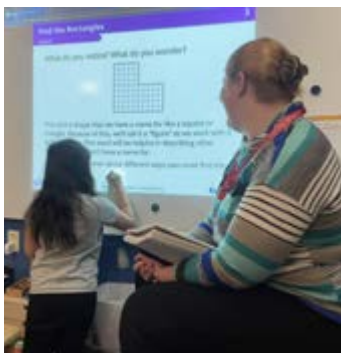
In 2024–2025, we will revise mathematics benchmarks for Kindergarten through 6th Grade, and update the math curriculum down to Grade 1.

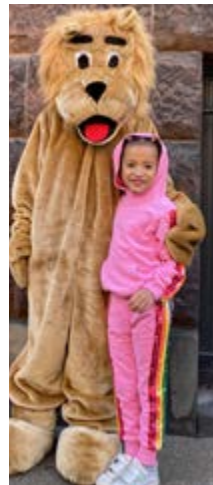


KINGSLEY GIVING DAY

Celebrating **85 YEARS**

The 2023-2024 school year marks the 85th Anniversary of our School's founding. In honor of this milestone, we share a brief campus history.

In 1938, Kingsley was established by Edith Kingsley and Helen Loud in a rented space at 480 Beacon Street. Kingsley moved to 397 Marlborough Street in 1945. Nearly fifty years ago, in 1974, Kingsley acquired 30 Fairfield Street. We operated our entire school from Fairfield until 2005, when we expanded into leased space on the second through fourth floors of 26 Exeter Street. In 2015, we renovated and expanded into the fifth floor of Exeter, while renovating parts of Fairfield, updating the Courtyard and creating the Movement Room. Today, along with recognizing our 85th anniversary, we are celebrating the recent purchase of 26 Exeter Street.

Thank you to all who have believed in and supported our school over the decades. Every student, staff member, family, and friend has contributed to Kingsley's 85-year journey. We look forward to continuing our collaboration on behalf of successive generations of resilient explorers, confident learners, and empathetic citizens.
